## Amendment to Local Rules

### DEER HOOF MARKS ON FAIRWAYS, IN SAND BUNKERS OR ON THE GREEN

A ball coming to rest in a deer hoof mark in a bunker may be lifted and relief taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.

Lift and drop the ball, IN THE BUNKER, without penalty, within one club length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole.

If complete relief is not available the ball may be dropped, as near as possible to the spot where the ball lay, IN THE BUNKER, at maximum available relief, not nearer the hole.

Identification of the perceived condition would have to be agreed with the playing partners before relief is taken.
